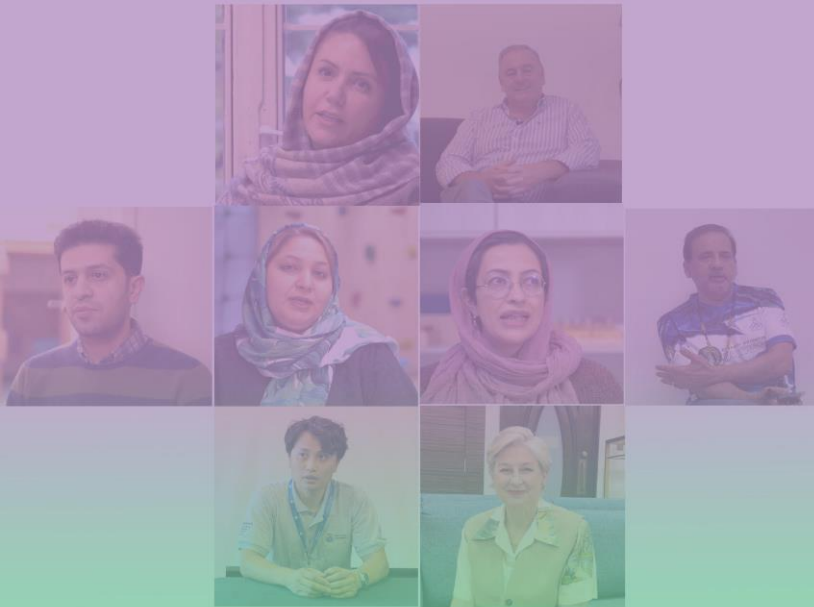

### Promoting the spirit of cooperation among the students

Encouraging social participation and democratic activities is among the main goals of cooperatives. Considering this fact, it should be mentioned that schools are one of the most effective institutions for promoting and developing this culture in society. To strengthen the sense of cooperation and to promote the spirit of accountability and teamwork, Rah-E Roshd Cultural and Educational Cooperative has implemented an essential program and has established important concepts: "Student Takeover Day" and "The Student Council".

### Student council and promoting social participation

The student council is an important entity in Rah-E Roshd cultural and educational cooperative, given the fact that the foundation of this organization was based on cooperation. Every year, after the Ministry of Education announces the time for the council election, students at all academic levels start participating in the council elections. A safe and free environment for election advertisements is provided for the candidates by the Rah-E Roshd cultural and educational cooperative, and student representatives are elected through a democratic election.





## Student Takeover Day

One of the most impactful initiatives of the Rah-E Roshd cultural and educational cooperative, which aims to increase the spirit of participation, responsibility, and management in students, is the "Student Takeover Day" event.

This event, held every year and at all academic levels, is an exercise and experience of management and decision-making for the personal and social life of the students. On this day, students learn about the professional challenges of a principal, deputy, moderator, teacher, and the rest of the school staff and learn how to make decisions in the professional field in their own school, where they go to learn every other day.

## Projects

Each year, students are provided with a variety of projects in the fields of engineering, basic sciences, interdisciplinary sciences, humanities, and art. They will then spend a year working on their chosen project and present them at the scientific research awards event of Rah-E Roshd.

## Attending The 16th Regional Assembly of the ICA-AP

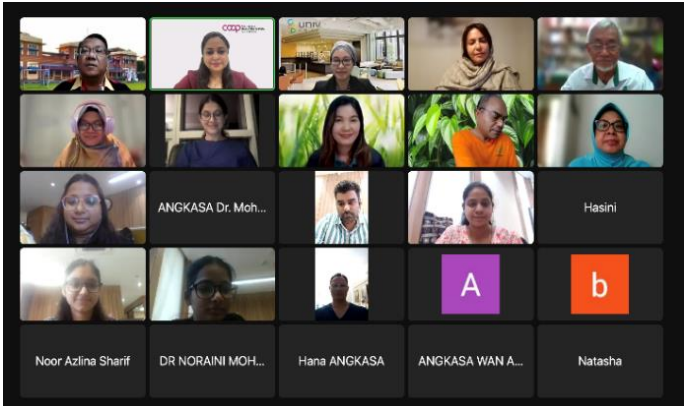
